This sensor voids the need for manual distributor timing. Because, The sensor (CKP) is used to determine which cylinder is firing to synchronize the fuel injector and coil firing sequence.

A camshaft position sensor is an electronic device that does what it suggests — monitor the camshaft position and speed — and feeds that data to the vehicle ' s engine control module (ECM). The ECM needs this data to control how much fuel enters the combustion chamber and ignition (spark) timing to ignite the fuel.

The camshaft position signal is used by the ECM to precisely time fuel injector operation. This is especially important with SFI. The signal is also used, along with the crankshaft position sensor, as part of the engine knock control strategy. A camshaft position sensor was not used on pre-GEMS systems.

Answer: The Camshaft Position Sensor (CMPS) and the Crankshaft Position Sensor (CKPS) are used by the ECU to determine the correct timing of firing the ignition to produce an optimum engine performance. (Other sensors may cause the ECU to alter the ignition timing for safety reasons).

This sensor communicates with the vehicle ' s ECU to control ignition timing and fuel injection parameters.
